

Master Lock Excell

Combo Padlock

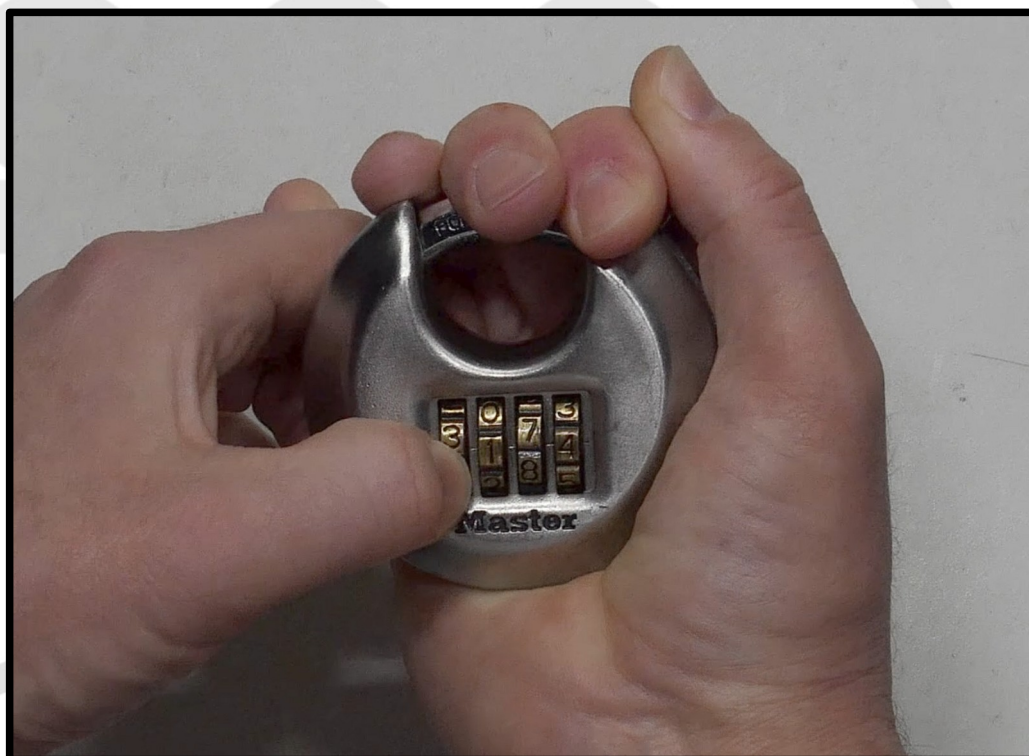
Difficulty: easy - intermediate.

These are really designed for outdoors use and you'll find them on construction sites. The mechanism and materials are robust against weather and a perfect example of why I use a Master Lock to hold up my washing line.

New ones are relatively easy but the intermediate difficulty comes from when you have to do this outside and the mechanism is crusty and giving all kinds of false feedback. Add in cold hands and you really can find this more challenging than it should be.

Technique:

- 1) Tension the opening mechanism (on the shackle).
- 2) Rotate the wheels until you find the binding wheel.
- 3) Rotate the first binding wheel one position at a time and test the adjacent wheel for binding.
- 4) When a wheel is set, the next wheel along will bind.
- 5) Keep going until the wheels are all lined up and the lock pops open.
